MyDFI – MEMBER PORTAL

Many resources are available to members when you sign in to MyDFI. Go to www.dfi.org and sign in with your email and password. If you don't have a password, a temporary one will be provided, which you can change once you are logged in.

Check Your Membership Status: When you sign in, your MyDFI screen will show your membership status and any outstanding dues.

Pay Dues: Pay your dues online by credit card or print an invoice for payment by check, or international money order/bank draft. You can also generate and forward the invoice via email to your accounts payable department.

Update Contact Info: Check that your contact information is correct in our database — click on “Contact Info” on the left-hand side and make any necessary changes.

Change Password: Change your password to MyDFI at any time.

View Members Roster: Access an up-to-date member roster of DFI individual and corporate members, complete with contact information. The roster is searchable by last name, company name or email address.

Log in to OneMine: Automatically log in to OneMine to access more than 135,000 free publications. This single login means you don't have to register or log in again on the OneMine site.

View the DFI Journal: Access current and past issues of the *Journal*.

Download DFI logos: Download a DFI logo (JPG and EPS format) to promote your membership by displaying the logo on your website, eNewsletters, emails, social media platforms (e.g., Facebook, LinkedIn, Twitter, etc.) and other marketing materials.

Access Student Resumes: Corporate Members can access resumes that have been provided by student members and students who have received or applied for DFI Educational Trust At-Large scholarships. Resumes can be sorted and filtered based on various criteria.

Access Online Proceedings: Access online programs, presentations and proceedings from DFI seminars and conferences that you have registered for and attended, or from online proceedings to which you have purchased access.

The DFI website at www.dfi.org is a valuable resource for members. Here's what you will find:
